OFFICE HOURS: The Show Office will be open at 12:30 pm – 8:00 pm Thursday, April 18th. During the competition, the office will open one hour before and close one hour following each show day. An **OPEN CHEQUE OR CREDIT CARD INFORMATION** will be required at the show office before exhibitor packages can be released. Faxed entries will be accepted to the Moose Jaw Exhibition Office at 306-692-2762 provided that they are accompanied by a phoned in payment by Visa or MasterCard. MJ Ex Co Office hours are Monday to Friday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, and the phone number is 306-692-2723.

STABLING: ALL HORSES MUST SHOW OUT OF A STALL. Stabling is assigned and will be available as of 9:00 am Thursday, April 18th until 9:00 pm Sunday, April 21st. Stall fees are set at \$75.00 per horse for the weekend – including stall clean out. Shavings may be ordered in advance on the entry forms. There *may* be additional shavings available for purchase during the event. Tack and feed stalls are available for \$50.00 for the weekend and **MUST** be purchased at time of entry. If you would like to arrive prior to, or stay beyond the times and dates specified, you must contact the Exhibition office in advance to book your stall(s) at an additional \$20.00 per horse per night.

UNLOADING: Trucks and trailers will be allowed twenty minutes for unloading at barn doors, and then must be parked in designated areas.

SCHOOLING ROUNDS OVER A MODIFIED HUNTER COURSE WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM 1:00 PM TO 7:45 PM THURSDAY, APRIL 18TH. Fifteen minute time blocks may be purchased for \$15 and **MUST** be paid for prior to riding. Time slots can be purchased by a single rider, or by a group/trainer. Groups will be charged per time slot used, rather than being charged as individual riders. **SCHOOLING ROUNDS WILL BE LIMITED TO NO MORE THAN 6 HORSES IN THE RING AT ONE TIME.** It is strongly recommended to hack your horse(s) in the Duncan so you do not have to spend much time hacking during your schooling round. Schooling rounds will be scheduled on a first come, first serve basis.

WARM UPS DURING SHOW: The Jack Duncan memorial building will be available for warm ups during the show. **Weather permitting,** the flat classes may be held outdoors in the West ring.

INHUMANE TREATMENT OF HORSES WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

The Moose Jaw Exhibition Company will not be held responsible for any damage, injury, loss, or theft to any person, or their animals, or their belongings.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES AND UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATION

ENTRIES must be in the hands of the show secretary by 5:00 pm Monday, April 15th, 2019. Entries will not be processed without payment. Entries received after the deadline **may not** be recorded in the program. All entries must be made in writing and signed by the owner/agent of the horse and the exhibitor. **The parent or legal guardian MUST sign entries of all JUNIOR riders and the junior's birthdate must be provided.** A separate entry form must be filled out for each horse/rider combination, and will be assigned a separate number.

LATE ENTRIES received after the closing date **WILL** be assessed a \$30 late fee, **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Additional classes may be added to your existing entry form without such late penalties.

REFUNDS/CLASS TRANSFERS: Management reserves the right to refund any entry. Exhibitors are responsible for errors on their entry forms and will not be refunded because of errors. No refunds or transfers on scratches after 6:00 pm Thursday, April 18th, 2019.

CANCELLATIONS: There will be no refund on entry fees after the official closing date of entries, except with a veterinary certificate stating that the horse will be unable to show during the show, or a doctor's certificate in the case of the participant. If less than 72 hours' notice is given, with a veterinarian or doctor's certificate, entry fee refunds may be reduced to 50% of the fees at the discretion of show management. **STABLING, PARAMEDIC, AND OFFICE FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.** If MJ Ex Co cancels the show due to weather, the office fees will be held and all other fees will be refunded

EXHIBITOR NUMBERS will be assigned per horse/rider combination and **MUST** be worn and visible at all times, including in the schooling rounds, exercise rings, as well as in the show ring. Any exhibitor entering the show ring without the correct exhibitor number may be excused from the class, or may be disqualified in the event of a subsequent protest.

POST ENTERING CLASSES must be done at the show office prior to the start of the class **NOT** at the gate. Any exhibitor adding in at the gate without following this rule may be disqualified. **ONCE A CLASS HAS BEGUN (THE GATE SHUT, OR THE FIRST HORSE JUDGED) NO FURTHER ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

MANAGEMENT reserves the right to cancel or combine any class that does not fill to their satisfaction, whereupon exhibitors shall be notified as soon as possible. The show management is not required to hold the gate for anyone not ready on time, this is a courtesy extended at the discretion of the show committee.

ATTIRE: Competitors should be neatly and suitably dressed in coat (*optional for cross rail and jumper classes*), an approved ASTM/SEI helmet, shirt, breeches, and boots with a heel. Half chaps are permissible providing they match the boot color. **Braiding is optional.** Protective head gear with properly secured and fastened harness which meets ASTM/SEI standards, properly fitted and in good condition, is compulsory for **ALL** competitors when mounted on a horse on the MJ Ex Grounds.

EXHIBITORS MAY RIDE MORE THAN ONE HORSE IN CLASSES REQUIRING ONLY INDIVIDUAL WORK, REGARDLESS OF AGE, UP TO A MAXIMUM OF THREE ENTRIES. HOWEVER, A HORSE CAN ONLY BE ENTERED ONCE IN EACH CLASS AT THE SHOW. IF THERE IS AN ELIMINATION ROUND, EACH HORSE MUST BE RIDDEN IN THE ACTUAL CLASS BY THE SAME RIDER WHO RODE IT IN THE FIRST ROUND.

EACH HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION MAY ENTER A MAXIMUM OF THREE (3) CONSECUTIVE HEIGHTS, AND A MAXIMUM OF FOUR (4) OVER-FENCE CLASSES PER DAY. THIS WOULD INCLUDE HUNTER CLASSES, JUMPER CLASSES, DERBIES, STAKES, SPECIALS, EQUITATION, AND MEDAL CLASSES (EXCLUDING HUNTER WARM UPS, JUMPER CLEAR-ROUNDS, AND HORS CONCOUR ROUNDS).

HORS CONCOURS IN HUNTERS: No horse or pony will be allowed to show "hors concours" in hunter classes or divisions.

HORS CONCOURS IN JUMPERS:

1. "Hors Concours" entries may be accepted at the competition committee's discretion but are subject to the same rules as a regular entry. Hors Concours may not participate in any jump-off.
2. A horse or pony that has competed "hors concours" is not permitted to be judged in the same ring on the same day. A horse or pony may only compete "hors concours" once in the same ring on the same day.

PROTESTS/COMPLAINTS must be made in writing. It must be submitted, along with \$25.00 cheque payable to MOOSE JAW EXHIBITION COMPANY, within **one hour** of the competition of the class in question. A protest must contain a specific statement of an alleged violation of a rule or condition of a class. It must provide the full name (and address, if possible) of the alleged violator. The show committee (and the judge, if they so choose) will review the protest and determine a ruling based on the rules and regulations under which the show is sanctioned. **If the show committee and/or judge is unable to come to a resolution, the matter will be referred to the SHF office and their policies for dispute resolution. The SHF's decision shall be final.** Protest fees will be returned only if the ruling is made in favor of the complainant. This procedure will take precedence over all other protest procedures.

MEMBERSHIPS: This is a Saskatchewan Horse Federation sanctioned show. Current SHF memberships in good standing are required for **ALL** exhibitors. Nominations into the Heritage Circuit and/or Prairie Cup Series are available from the SHF office, and must be acquired prior to the start of the show in order to collect points. Please purchase your memberships early, and be sure to include a photocopy of all required memberships along with your entry forms.

WARM UP TO SPRING SCHOOLING ROUNDS TIME REQUEST FORM

Thursday, April 18, 2019

Rules/Regulations:

1. Fifteen minute time blocks may be purchased for \$15. Payment must be attached with the warm up request form.
2. Time slots can be purchased by a single rider, or by a group of riders. **Groups will be charged per time slot used, rather than being charged as individual riders.** All horse/riders must be registered with the competition to be eligible for a warm-up time.
3. Schooling rounds will be limited to no more than 6 horses in a ring at one time.
4. MJ Ex Co will not be responsible for grouping people together to share the ring.
5. Each horse/rider combination is only allowed to book 1 fifteen minute time slot. A rider can book more than 1 fifteen minute time slot if riding a different horse in each time slot.
6. All warm-up requests will be scheduled on a first come, first serve basis.
7. All riders must be a member of the SHF.
8. Riders will be notified of warm up schedule the Wednesday before competition via email.
9. Professional etiquette must be maintained by all competitors and coaches.
10. No riders will be allowed to ride in the ring during the warm-up time without purchasing a block of time.
11. Other warm up arenas will be available for use.
