Prize Payout – Please note the minimum entries below for class payout(s):

1st Place: \$10.00; **2nd Place:** \$6.00; **3rd Place:** \$4.00

Stake classes will have a \$10 add back from the entries in the class. Payouts will be: 50%; 30%, 20%

- There **must be** 4 entries in a class to payout 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place dollars.
- There **must be** 3 entries in a class to payout 1st and 2nd place dollars.
- There **must be** 2 entries in a class to payout 1st place dollars.

General Information

This is a Saskatchewan Horse Federation sanctioned horse show. Current SHF memberships in good standing are required for all exhibitors. Nominated riders are eligible to earn points from placings in Heritage classes and these points will count towards year end awards. Please ensure your SHF membership is current and that you have nominated, if you are interested in accumulating points for the awards. To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals (Sept 27-29, 2019), you must attend a minimum of two Heritage shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible.

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill to their satisfaction; whereupon exhibitors shall be notified as soon as possible after close of entries. Classes may also be split if entries warrant. Any class(es) with less than 3 entries, will be cancelled or combined at managements discretion.

All dogs must be on a leash.

SHF Membership is required for all competitors.

SHF Helmet Policy: all youth under the age of 18 as of January 1 of the current year will be required to wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet when participating in any event sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation. This is for safety and insurance purposes.

Dress English competitors should be neatly and suitably dressed in a coat, prescribed helmet, shirt, breeches and boots with a heel. Half chaps are permissible providing they match the boot color. Western exhibitors must wear appropriate western attire, including a shirt with long sleeves and collar, western hat or approved helmet, western pant with belt, and cowboy boots.

BRAIDING IS OPTIONAL.

A horse can only be entered into a class once at the discretion of the Show Committee.

Each rider/horse combination may enter a maximum of three consecutive jump heights, and a maximum of four over fence classes, in the Hunters & Jumpers.

No Cross Entry from walk trot classes to canter classes per rider/horse combination. Walk trotters may enter cross rail.

Tack Change will allow you a two minute gate hold *ONLY* upon advance request to the gate personnel.

Hunter/Jumper Warm Up Rounds will be available Friday, September 6 until 2:00-8:00 p.m. at the cost of \$15 for 15 minutes per horse/rider.

Stabling will be assigned. **No feed/tack/chairs in the aisle ways please.**

Stall Clean Out is not required when you leave. **No staples, nails, screws or tacks in the stalls – hook overs and ties only please.**

Entries/Payment received after 5:00 p.m. Friday, August 30 will be assessed a \$30 late fee. For more information, please contact **The Moose Jaw Exhibition Office** (306-692-2723; moosejawexh@sasktel.net)
